

Turn-Over Ceremony of the Donated Educational Reading Materials from Move on Philippines to New Dumangas Elementary School and Colon National High School

Documentation

Move on Philippines is a charitable, non-stock, non-profit organization of Filipinos based in the state of Florida, USA and a member of Jacksonville Asian American Alliance. From their workplace, its members collect books and useful educational equipments from schools and other possible institutions usable for schools in the Philippines. The organization has recognized this need in their country especially in Mindanao. Numerous schools have expressed their need for supplementary textbooks through letters to Move on Philippines and to its partner in development in Mindanao, Mahintana Foundation, Inc.

Mahintana is another private non-stock, non-profit socio-economic development oriented organization whose programs and services are geared towards environmental conservation and regeneration, livelihood and enterprise development, cooperative development and institution building, and basic social services. Last January, 2008 Move on Philippines sent one (1) "*balikbayan*" box to Mahintana as its partner in distributing these reading books to identified schools in Southern Mindanao.

A total of 188 pieces of books, which includes the four (4) volumes of Funk and Wagnalls New Encyclopedia and the two (2) volumes of funk and Wagnalls Standard Desk Dictionary. These books were distributed to two (2) schools, New Dumangas Elementary School in Tboli, Province of South Cotabato and Colon National High School in Maasim, Province of Sarangani. The books were sorted to reading books for high schools and for pupils depending on the level of content of the books.

New Dumangas Elementary School is one of the adopted schools of Dole Philippines and Mahintana, which is located six (6) to eight (8) kilometers away from the town proper and whose teachers attend to school by riding a single motorcycle. The school has a mini-library whose books are now obsolete and tedious to the eyes of the pupils. Reading books suited to the interest of the elementary pupils were expected to be useful to a total of 470 pupils of the school.

In this School, 98 reading books, four (4) volumes of Funk and Wagnalls New Encyclopedia and two (2) volumes of Funk and Wagnalls Standard Desk Dictionary were given. A ceremonial turn-over of books was held consecutively with the school's family day last February 14, 2008 at the mini-gym of New Dumangas Elementary School Campus. In a warm welcoming message of the school principal, Mr. Juberto E. Jumantoc expressly shared how fortunate the school is because of the assistance coming from Dolefil, Mahintana and now Move on Philippines. His pupils have also expressed this appreciation by presenting a field demonstration participated by pupils of Grade IV, V and VI.

In behalf of the three organizations which are, Dolefil, Mahintana, and Move on Philippines, Mr. Martiniano L. Magdolot, the executive director of Mahintana, expected the books to be stained and dirtied after few months to indicate the books are in read wisely by the pupils. Reading in wide array of knowledge is important according to him. Learning different field of knowledge at an early age will mean preparing to be well rounded individuals and become successful later on of their life. The books were

turned-over by Mr. Magdolot, and accepted by Mr. Jumantoc and Mr. Sergio L. Digdigan Sr., the school's general Parents, Teachers and Community Association (PTCA) President.

In Colon National High School 80 reading books were given through Mahintana. Colon National High School is one of the only two high schools in Maasim. The insufficient number of books found in the school's reading center lead their request for supplemental reading materials to Mahintana. The teachers of the school initiated to build a reading center in the school to enhance the reading skills of the students especially the first year level. Originally the request of the school was the provision of SRA sets for their non-reader students. However, the school was grateful with the supplemental books to be placed in their reading center. For the total of 1600 students that the school has, their reading center will eventually be filled with reference books useful for their students.

During the turn over, the supreme students' government president, Juvelyn B. Llego has emphasized to emulate Jose Rizal as a role model of her fellow-students. On her message to the crowd, reading books as a habit will help improve the personal well-being of the self as a student and will help them become functional citizen in the future just like the national hero.

The "Papaya Boys" composed of the fourth year male students of the school prepared a dance intermission number as a way showing the schools' appreciativeness of organizations such as Move on Philippines, Mahintana and Dolefil that keeps on helping the school. Mr. Magdolot gave the books in behalf of Move on Philippines and was accepted by the school principal, Mrs Zenaida Arciaga. On his message, Mr. Magdolot committed to hand in assistance for the development of the school and the municipality of Maasim. He has further discuss, Dolefil and Mahintana is on the way of supporting the basic social services in the municipality. In education per se, the Chairs-for-Trees and the Adopt-A-School Project is being sustained to help enhance the quality education in partnership with the Department of Education. The development thrust in Maasim towards social and economic development is being planned with the different partners now with another partner, Move on Philippines.

Despite its being an institution for higher education, the Colon National High School still lacks facilities needed in the school such as science laboratory, multi-media apparatus and even desk dictionaries. Next steps we, together with other schools who are in need of reading books, are soliciting from Move on Philippines more reading materials and equipments for the school usable in the enhancement of quality of education especially in Southern Mindanao.
