PROFILE

INTRODUCTION:

Proverbsville has taken its name from the Book of Wisdom-PROVERBS. This book of the Bible teaches not only the WHAT about life (knowledge), and the WHY about living (understanding) but it emphasizes above all the HOW or the application of both knowledge and understanding. Proverbsville therefore, provides for the learning environment that enables children to adapt themselves to real life situations. Proverbsville School, Inc. is both sectarian and non-sectarian. It is Christian because it has Christ at the Center of its Educational Philosophy and the Bible as the Source of Education. It is also considered Non-sectarian because it accepts all children whose parents come from all religious affiliations. It is a private school run by individuals with a common vision for quality education. It is registered with the Securities and Exchange Corporation (SEC) as a non-stock, non-profit corporation, with its assets and income used directly for educational purposes. All branches are duly recognized by the Department of Education.

OUR PHILOSOPHY:

Proverbsville School, Inc. is an institution aimed at providing basic education: pre-elementary, elementary and secondary. It was conceived to provide quality education that is based on the timeless principles of the Holy Bible. We believe that when a child is grounded in the truths of God's Word, he is better equipped to face a changing world. He is also able to make learning relevant to his daily challenges. At Proverbsville, quality education is perceived to be holistic. It emanates from a meaningful relationship with God and expresses itself in academic and character excellence.

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In School Year 1996-97, Proverbsville Learning Center opened at Manuel L. Quezon St., Sto. Cristo, Angeles City. With forty four pre-schoolers and three teachers, it offered quality education with emphasis on developmentally appropriate curriculum and strong character development.

On its fourth school year 1999-2000, because of its growing population, Proverbsville Learning Center Inc., having changed its name to Proverbsville School, Inc., moved its main office to Villa Teresa Subdivision Extension. However, the M.L. Quezon branch continued to offer pre-elementary courses for pre-school children. On that year, the school earned its Government Recognition for its complete pre-elementary and elementary courses. On the same year, the First Year Secondary level started with 12 students.

On its 6th year, Proverbsville purchased its first property which housed the secondary students at No. 34-6 Ma. Teresa Street , Villa Teresa Subdivision Extension. It was on this year that Proverbsville School, Inc. was in three locations- the main building at No.32-5-7 Flora Avenue, Villa Teresa which housed the pre-elementary and elementary pupils, the M.L. Quezon branch offered courses for the pre-elementary pupils and the high school building at Ma. Teresa had the complete secondary levels for the first time. Proverbsville's Secondary Course was also given full recognition on the same year. In April 2003, Proverbsville School, Inc. graduated its first batch of 12 senior students in the secondary level. On its 8th graduation rites, Proverbsville has graduated a total of 50 students in the secondary level. Last October of AY 2006-2007, Proverbsville School, Inc. celebrated its 10th year with the dedication of its school lot and building located at Telabastagan, City of San Fernando.

Now, on its 13th year, Proverbsville School, Inc. is projecting to buy a bigger lot at its present location and main office. '''
