

Turn-over of Books and Educational Materials to Ranao Elementary School

RATIONALE:

Education remains to be a stumbling block instead of a catalyst to human and social development in the Philippines, especially the remote areas in Mindanao. Access to decent education in these remote areas is hampered by, among others, poor infrastructure, non-energization of the community, poverty, insufficient educational materials, tools, equipment and other attendant schooling needs.

Two non-profit organizations, Move On Philippines (Move On) and Mindanao Land Foundation (MinLand) agreed to collaborate in helping address the needs of school children and teachers in schools in disadvantaged communities by providing educational materials, technologies for learning and classroom supplies.

GENERAL IMPLEMENTATION SCHEME:

Move On gathers educational materials, technologies for learning and classroom supplies from donors in the Philippines and overseas for the intention of donating the same to school beneficiaries it has pre-selected according to the criteria it has also previously set and approved.

Move On, upon concurrence of MinLand, conveys these materials to MinLand, one of its identified partners in Mindanao, Philippines.

Minland physically delivers the donated materials to the pre-identified beneficiaries.

Other collaborators and intermediaries to assist in the delivery of the shipment shall also be drawn in whenever and wherever possible and available.

REMARKS
